HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Program

The Heart of Texas Homeless Coalition is the collaborative applicant for the annual CoC Program competitive grant from HUD.

Purpose of the CoC Program:

- Promote a community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness
- Provide funding for efforts to re-house homeless individuals/families rapidly while minimizing the trauma and dislocation caused to homeless individuals, families, and communities as a consequence of homelessness
- Promote access to and effective use of mainstream programs by homeless individuals and families
- Optimize self-sufficiency among individuals/families experiencing homelessness



Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)

HMIS is a computerized data collection application designed to capture client-level information on characteristics and service needs of homeless persons and persons in need of assistance.

HOTHOC utilizes HMIS to:

- Enhance interagency coordination
- Determine scope of homelessness
- Optimize usage of resources
- Provide more effective and streamlined referrals
- Collect data for reporting and grant/funding compliance
